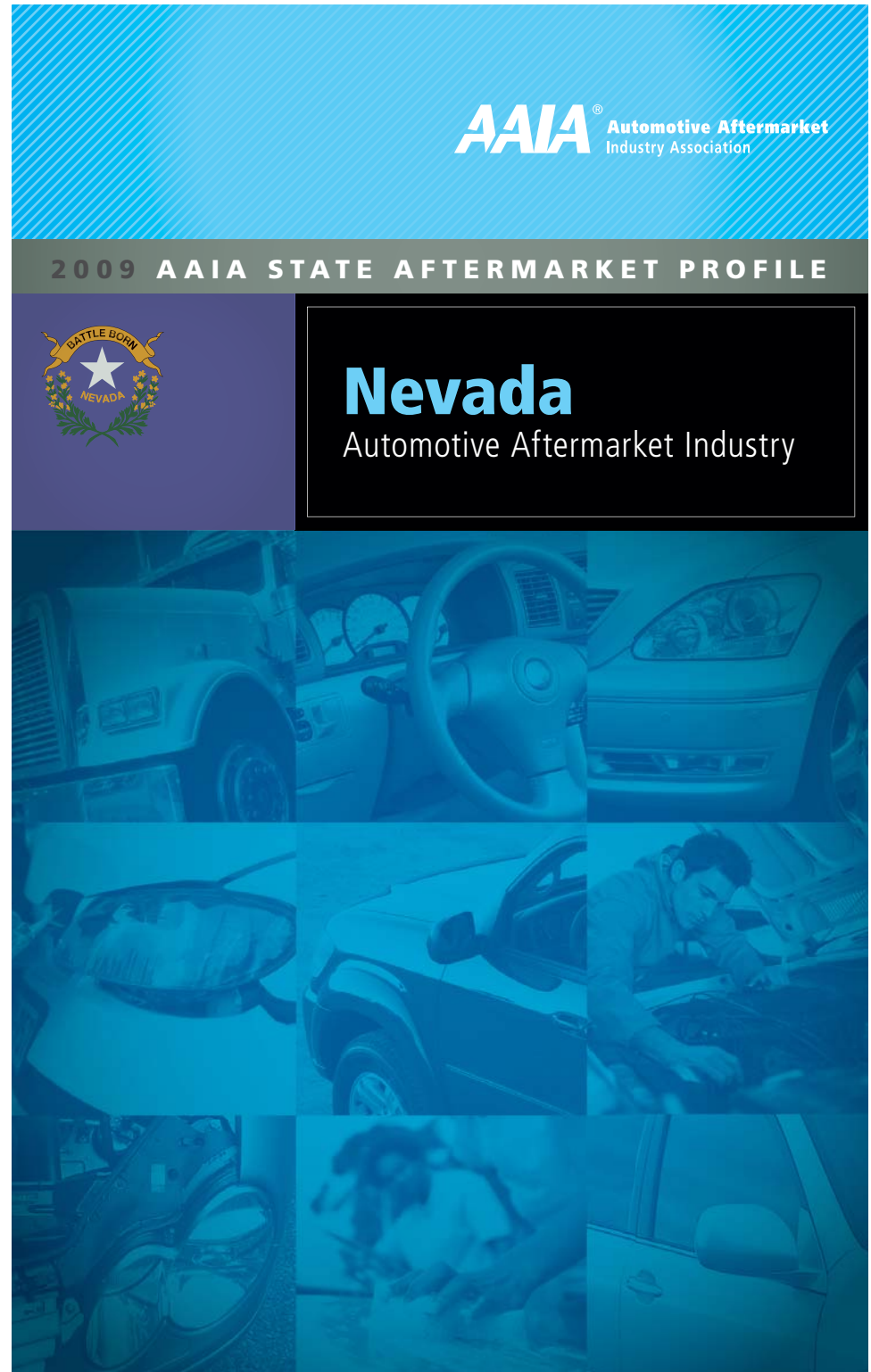

## Nevada's Automotive Aftermarket Industry

### Summary:

The aftermarket industry supplies the products and services that are fundamental to the proper maintenance and repair of passenger cars, minivans, sports cars, pickups, heavy-duty and sport utility vehicles. Our industry manufactures, distributes and sells motor vehicle parts, accessories, service, tools, equipment, materials and supplies. Typically, aftermarket jobs are located in repair shops, automotive parts stores, warehouse distributors, and tire dealerships.

Nevada's aftermarket industry is vital to the state's economy. The state employs 15,441 people in the aftermarket industry, representing roughly 1.2% of the state's total workforce, and is home to 1.7 million vehicles. Annual aftermarket sales in Nevada are approximately \$2.4 billion.

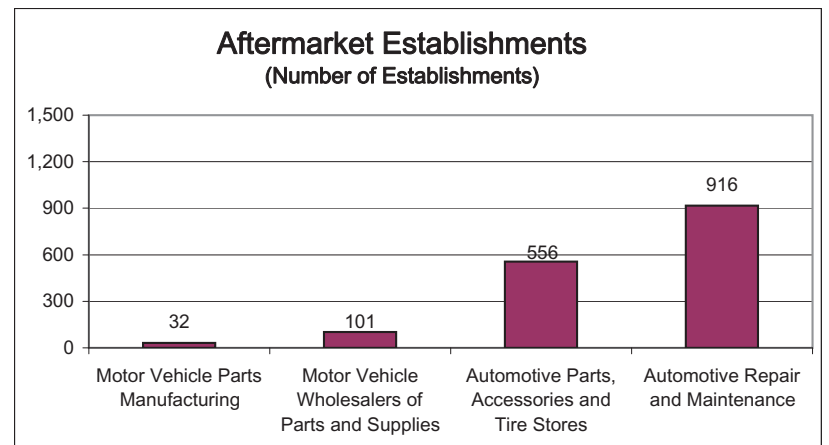
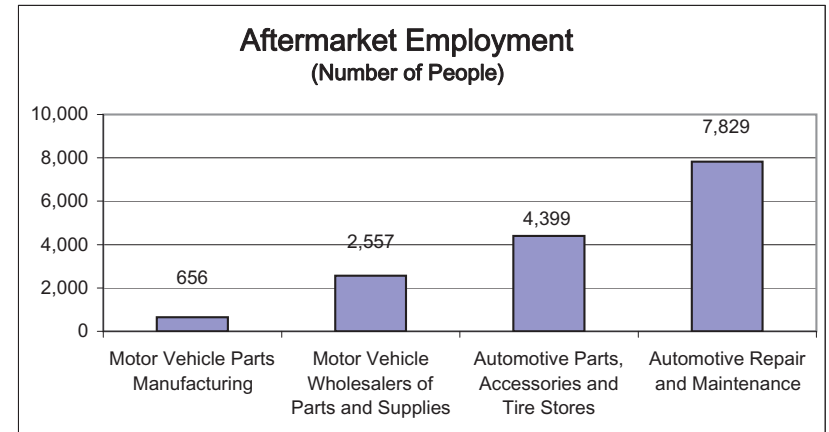

Nationally, the U.S. aftermarket industry is a major contributor to the U.S. economy. It generates annual sales of approximately \$285.5 billion (2.1 percent of the U.S. GDP), as it provides the products and services needed to support the nation's 250 million registered vehicles and 206 million licensed drivers. In addition, the aftermarket employs 4.4 million people nationwide, representing about 3.3 percent of the workforce.
